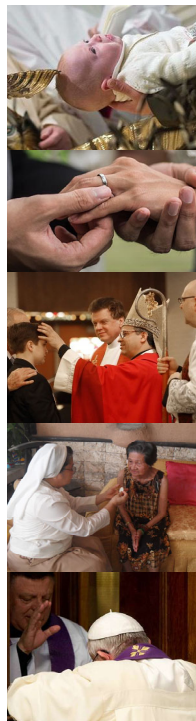

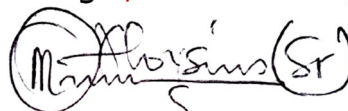
Queridos feligreses de St. James,

4. Catholics who have received all their Sacraments but who want to learn more about their faith.

RCIA classes are held at St. James. Due the the Pandemic, RCIA classes are offered via online program. Classes begin in October 2020.

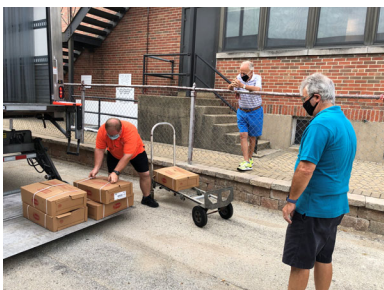

Statement of the Archdiocese of Chicago on its Reopening Plan for its Schools

The Archdiocese of Chicago created a reopening plan for its schools that places the health and safety of our students, teachers and employees above all else. It meets the strict Illinois Department of Public Health requirements and was developed with input from all of our stakeholders, including teachers as well as public health authorities and medical experts. As the school year progresses, we will continue to follow the guidance of authorities, monitor compliance with the plan and make adjustments accordingly.

The Office of Catholic Schools employs more than 5,000 in administrative, teaching and staff positions. They have worked together to respond to this extraordinary challenge and continue our education mission. The opening of more than 70 schools this week has been greeted with enthusiasm by our families, students and teachers. The mixture of in-person and on-line learning they offer differs from school to school and responds to parent choice. If families choose remote learning, they are accommodated.

Our Office of Catholic School has repeatedly directed employees with concerns to speak with their principals or send their concerns to the Archdiocese for response. We have diligently responded to principal and employee concerns brought to our attention. However, we cannot accommodate all requests. Given the preference of a majority of families for in-person learning, remote teaching opportunities are limited. To the extent possible, teachers who choose to work remotely are accommodated either at their original school or by applying to another school with remote teaching opportunities.

Han trabajado juntos para responder a este extraordinario desafío y continuar nuestra misión educativa. La apertura de más de 70 escuelas esta semana ha sido recibida con entusiasmo por nuestras familias, estudiantes y profesores. La combinación de aprendizaje en persona y en línea que ofrecen difiere de una escuela a otra y responde a la elección de los padres. Si las familias optan por el aprendizaje a distancia, se les acomoda.

Nuestra Oficina de Escuelas Católicas ha dirigido repetidamente a los empleados con inquietudes que hablen con sus directores o envíen sus inquietudes a la Arquidiócesis para obtener una respuesta. Hemos respondido diligentemente a las inquietudes del director y de los empleados que se nos han informado. Sin embargo, no podemos atender todas las solicitudes. Dada la preferencia de la mayoría de las familias por el aprendizaje en persona, las oportunidades de enseñanza a distancia son limitadas. En la medida de lo posible, los profesores que optan por trabajar de forma remota se alojan en su escuela de origen o solicitando admisión a otra escuela con oportunidades de enseñanza a distancia.



Equitable Allocation of COVID-19 Vaccine

MESSAGE OF CARDINAL BLASE J. CUPICH TO ALL ARCHDIOCESE OF CHICAGO PRIESTS

Dear Fathers,

In anticipation of a safe and effective vaccine against the Covid-19 contagion, which could be available for distribution as soon as 2021, public authorities are now seeking input regarding formulating policies for the equitable allocation of the vaccine in our country.

As the information in this enclosed [link](#) indicates, public hearings starting this week will solicit verbal and written input from individuals and community leaders. Please review and share with your local community the information below.

It is important that the whole community participates. Active and reflective engagement through various listening sessions is an important contribution to the ethics of compassionate and inclusive healthcare. Specifically, we need to be clear about how population-wide, tax-supported doses across the country will be accessible to meet all the nation's needs. An agreed upon approach should meet distributive and social justice values that inform municipal, county, state and Federal governments' health personnel and foreseeably the various medical divisions of state and national military.

We might well understand that not all can receive a vaccination on the first day and there needs to be a prioritization of recipients, such as health care workers, police, firefighters, and other first responders, followed by at-risk individuals. At the same time, it is also a priority to ensure that those on the margins of society are considered and made active participants in this discussion. Pastorally, we can use this process to help offset social inequities, engage our neighbors and help build a healthier and just Chicago area community.

Please share this information with your parishioners and others in your community so that input can be fully inclusive. If you have comments or questions on this or related matters, please contact my Vicar for Health Affairs, Father William Grogan.
